General Show Rules

1. For the execution of this event, regulations of the PHCG as well as the current Official APHA Rule Book and this announcement apply

By submitting the entry, the participant/horse owner acknowledges the regulations applicable to the event.

2. PHCG Futurity / Maturity

The regulations of the current APHA rule book and the PHCG Futurity-/Maturity regulations apply.

The Weanling Halter will be divided if there are more than 10 entries for the respective sex class. The classes will only be divided after the late entry deadline has expired.

3. „All Paint Registries“ classes

Since this year APHA allows all disciplines listed in the rule SC-185.F to be held as a “All Paint Registries” class. This means that Solid Paint-Bred and Regular registered Paint Horses are able to start in the same class. As PHCG delegates already decided, there will be only one overall placing and one title for these combined classes. However, the APHA will continue to award points based on the number of horses of the respective registration type.

Example:

Open SPB Western Riding can be held class-in-class with the Open Western Riding. In this case, the classes are merged, but the final results recorded by the APHA for APHA points are kept separate. Therefore, the points for the Open SPB Western Riding are based on the number of SPB horses and the points for the Open Western Riding are based on the number of horses registered as a regular. This may mean that a SPB will be “German Champion Open Western Riding” but will not get any APHA points due to any other SPB’s in this class.

4. Late Entries:

Entries of horse-rider combinations not yet entered must be made via the online portal. From 02.08 on, additional fees will be charged here. Already entered combinations can send changes or additions by email to the registration office. Here too, from 02.08 onwards, additional entry fees may be due

Late entries are only possible in classes that have not been deleted at the entry deadline and only if they are reported up to two days before the class is held. (Example: The class takes place on Friday, the entry must be made by Wednesday at the latest)

5. Refunds:

Presenting a vet/med certificate **before the entry deadline** we will refund all of the entry and stall fees, Office Charge is not refundable.

Presenting a vet/med certificate **after the entry deadline** we will refund half of the entry fees, Office Charge is not refundable. Fees for stalls are only refunded if the Show Management can rent out those stalls again to other parties.

Futurity- and Maturity entry fees will in principle not be refunded, according to the Futurity/Maturity rules and regulations.



6. Doping:

By submitting the entry form, riders, exhibitors and horse owners agree to the drug testing (urine and/or blood) of their horses. A horse cannot be shown in any class if a prohibited substance has been administered to the animal in any manner. Prohibited substances are those set forth in the current Official APHA Rule Book as well as the current FEI list of prohibited substances. The Show Manager decides in any individual case if a medication will be accepted (medication sheet). In case of violations, horse owners, riders and horses will be disqualified from the entire event. By submitting the entry form, the horse owner/participant agrees to bear the entire costs of the doping test in case of a positive result and to give back any titles, awards and prize moneys won.

7. Vaccination/Equine Passport/Health Certificate:

Each horse must be disease free and must come from a disease free stable. The horse must also be vaccinated against influenza. Vaccination for EHV is optional but strongly recommended by Show Management.

The Equine Passport including the certificate of vaccination must accompany the horse and shown at the Show Office upon request.

Horses stalled outside of Germany must submit a health certificate.

8. Clipping:

Paint Horse Club Germany e.V. will control his members if their horses are clipped. Clipped horses can't get any titles. The rules could be found at www.phcg.de.

National laws in Germany prohibit all clipping of hair around nose, mouth, eyes and inside ears. If a horse is clipped, the person in charge of the horse is subject to disciplinary action by the state veterinarian.

9. Data protection:

With sending the entry form, all listed fields will be transferred to PHCG e.V. and thus to the show office mentioned in the announcement. The use is for hosting the show and the associated release in the program, on the entry list and the result list. The results are passed on to the American Paint Horse Association at Fort Worth/USA. The legality of this processing is given by the condition GDPR Art 6 (1) b – “processing to fulfil a contract”. Participation at this show without acknowledging this point is not possible. Due to new german regulations (Viehverkehrsordnung) data on the stable address of participating horses will be stored.

10. Other Provisions:

- a. The organizer reserves the right to change the announcement or schedule, to cancel, to reschedule the show or to cancel it and refund the fees if it is required by special circumstances.
- b. Classes could be cancelled if there are less than three entries. Entry fees will be paid back in this case. Classes could also be combined regarding the APHA Rulebook.
- c. Each horse must be liability insured.
- d. Each horse owner at submitting his/her entry, each companion and visitor when entering the show area, agrees with the directives and instructions of the organizer and accepts the regulations of the Official APHA Rule Book and the Rules and Regulations outlined here.
- e. With the submission of the entry form, the participant accepts to be photographed and/or filmed at the event and gives the consent for publishing of the pictures or footage. In addition, preparation areas and show arenas are possibly video-monitored. Photographers and videographers commissioned by the Show Management have exclusive rights. No other photographer or videographer is allowed to offer pictures of the event for sale. Private photographing is solely allowed outside the arena.



- g. There is no contractual relationship between the organizer on the one hand and the visitors, competitors, exhibitors and owners on the other hand. Hence any liability for theft and damage to a person or animal shall be excluded. In particular participants are not vicarious agents within the meaning of § 278 of the German Civil Code (BGB).
- h. A horse that is clipped could not get PHCG titles, PHCG prize money or prizes. Horses will be controlled before each class.
- i. The organizer reserves the right to send up to 3 exhibitors into the arena during Paid Warm Up Trail. Hereby the time of the single exhibitor is not extended.

11. International German Paint Horse Championship:

1. Participation Authorization

The exhibitor of the horse must be PHCG member to get titles, also foreign participants could get International German Champion. Eligible are only horses that are owned by a PHCG member. In syndicates at least one person must be PHCG member. Legal persons as owner of the horse must be also PHCG member. Clipped horses can't get any title.

2. International German Champion-Title

International German Champion titles will be awarded in the categories Youth, Novice Amateur, Amateur, Open, Youth SPB, Amateur SPB and Open SPB. A horse can only be International German Champion if it is owned by a PHCG member at the time of the show. The International German Champion will be determined from the results of the APHA shows. There will be no final run. In "All Paint registries" classes will be only one title, even if SPB and Regular are combined.

3. Medals

- 1 & 2 Starters: No titles will be awarded
- 3 & 4 Starters: A Gold Medal will be awarded
- 5 Starters: A Gold and Silver Medal will be awarded
- 6 & more Starters: Gold, Silver and Bronze Medal will be awarded

In scored classes International German Champions will be determined by adding the scores. In placed classes medal winners will be determined by adding up using the accompanying scale:

1.Place: 66 Points	2. Place: 55 Points	3. Place: 45 Points	4.Place: 36 Points	5.Place: 28 Points	6.Place: 21 Points

No result will be scratched. Ties are broken by a tie-breaker judge. The tie-breaker judge will be announced before the start of the class

12. Corona / Covid 19:

Due to the corona pandemic, this year's German Paint is subject to some additional rules:

By sending in the entry form the participant declares that he/she will follow the rules below and that he/she releases the organizer from any liability regarding a virus infection.

The applicable official hygiene and infection protection regulations of the Bavarian state must be observed: <https://www.stmgp.bayern.de/coronavirus/rechtsgrundlagen/>

- No spectators are allowed on the show ground
- Persons with symptoms of corona/COVID-19 or other contagious diseases or acute respiratory diseases are not allowed to enter the show ground
- Persons who have had contact with COVID-19 cases in the last 14 days are not allowed to enter the show ground
- Should users of the show area develop symptoms such as fever or respiratory problems typical of COVID-19 during their stay, they must leave the show area immediately.
- PHCG e.V. is neither entitled nor obliged to collect independent health data of users in this context.
- The instructions of the PHCG e.V. staff and representatives of the authorities must be followed at all times
- The householder's rights are consistently used against persons who do not comply with the regulations.
- The general distance requirement of 1.5 m must be observed
- The official hygiene and infection protection regulations (e.g. distance regulations) also apply in stable areas and on the trailer parking lot
- Regular hand hygiene with soap and running water is necessary
- All given possibilities of ventilation of premises are to be used
- Wearing a mouth and nose cover is based on the official regulations, i.e. that in closed rooms (e.g. stables, gastronomy, sanitary facilities), especially when passing through "narrow places" such as entrance areas, corridors etc., a suitable mouth and nose cover must be worn.
- All persons have to bring a sufficient number of mouth-nose covers with them, so that individual hygiene is possible during the entire duration of the tournament.
- A maximum of two registered accompanying persons per participant is allowed, a replacement of accompanying persons during the show is not possible
- For participants and accompanying persons a registration form must be filled in and handed in on arrival. This is used for contact person tracking and will be destroyed 6 weeks after the event.
- Participants and accompanying persons will each receive a wristband, which must always be worn on the show grounds. Persons without a wristband will be expelled from the show ground
- Sufficient washing facilities with liquid soap and disposable towels are provided.
- Camping is allowed, but you must park in such a way that the minimum distance can be maintained. Showers are probably not open.
- Participants please park directly at the booked stable to minimize ways.
- It is imperative that the given stalls is adhered to. In particular, empty boxes are to be kept as such.

- The recommendation of the BRFV is to limit the number of horses to one horse per 100 square metres.
The following maximum occupancy rates of the halls or places are derived from this:
Ostbayernhalle: max. 30 horses at a time
Event hall, training hall: max. 20 horses at a time
Stadium: max. 50 horses at the same time
Large outdoor arenas: max. 20 horses at a time, with the smaller outdoor arenas correspondingly fewer.
- A maximum of 100 persons (riders, accompanying persons, employees) are allowed to enter the riding halls at the same time. Spectators have no access.
- The show office can only be reached personally on arrival. A mouth and nose cover must be worn in this area.
- Working orders and result lists will be published at www.horseshowtracker.com
- All changes/renominations etc. can only be made by telephone (on site +49 9624 919 6071) or by e-mail/online. Before the start of the show we will give you a mobile phone number so that changes/requests for the starting order can be made by SMS / What's App.

Due to official regulations, the points mentioned are obligatory for the show participants and their accompanying persons. Violations of these obligations not only jeopardise further participation in the show, but may also jeopardise the entire show. The compliance with these regulations is not only monitored by us, but also by the authorities, especially by the police. Violations will result in legal and police measures and exclusion from the show.

Facilitations/relaxations will of course be passed on as far as organisationally possible. If further restrictions are ordered by the authorities, these must be strictly implemented, even if they restrict the rights of the show participants and accompanying persons or even lead to a cancellation of the show.

If the show cannot take place due to official decisions, the PHCG e.V. is not liable for damages - regardless of the legal grounds. If the show is cancelled by official decision, the PHCG e.V. will attempt to refund entry fees already paid after deduction of all obligations entered into in connection with the show. The amount of the refund is at the discretion of the PHCG e.V. Board and is final.

Should the show be cancelled due to official decisions, the above regulations regarding compensation and repayment of entry fees shall apply. If a show is cancelled due to the misconduct or non-compliance with the hygiene and safety regulations of individual participants or their accompanying persons, the PHCG e.V. reserves the right to take recourse to these participants or accompanying persons in the event of any damages or claims for compensation and to assert these damages through legal action.

By submitting an entry, the rules are accepted by the participant as well as by the persons accompanying him. In addition to the acceptance of the above by entry and arrival, the participants will receive all updated rules on arrival for review and signature. Without signature no participation in the show is possible.
